Beds in the Westfalia range combine great comfort, advanced safety and a stylish design. The height can be adjusted with the help of a stable yet sleek **scissor mechanism**. The head and footboards can be designed with an individual note in a range of **different variations**.


The Westfalia IV care bed combines all these advantages while offering good value for money. With an adjustable height range of **35 to 80 cm**, its lowest position is not far off the ground and contributes to fall prevention even without the use of safety sides. With the aid of the ergonomic, selectively lockable **handset**, the bed can be infinitely adjusted to a convenient height for getting in and out of bed.

The 80 cm maximum working height allows relatives and carers to work at a **back-friendly** height and communicate with the resident at eye level. If necessary, the full-length safety sides reliably protect the person in need of care. The height of the safety sides allows the use of anti-decubitus systems.

Westfalia-Klassik

The Westfalia-Klassik is designed for discerning users who are not prepared to compromise on comfort and sophisticated technical features in their daily care routine. This care bed looks good in every situation: If the full-length safety side is lowered, its bars rest on top of each other **without a gap**. When it is raised, **attractive wooden panels** conceal the bed frame along both sides of the bed.

With its adjustable height range of **35 to 80 cm**, the Westfalia-Klassik promotes fall prevention, can be easily adjusted to the ideal height for getting in and out of bed and allows caregivers to work at a back-friendly height.

The 4-section metal mattress base, with its **sliding backrest**, is designed to adapt to any position that the resident wishes to adopt and follows the natural movement of the resident's body during adjustment. Its slats are designed for easy and thorough cleaning.


The Westfalia Klassik features a **central braking system** as standard. One press of the brake lever is enough to securely immobilise the bed.

The Sky-fit and Comfort-fit models are also reversible mattresses with one smooth and one cutout side. As a result, these mattresses are never "too hard" or "too soft" – they can simply be turned over and offer two different lying experiences.

Sky-fit – the premium model

- High-quality dual-layer mattress with a 2-cm Skytherm® top layer and a 12-cm cold foam
- Cutouts in the base layer ensure optimum adaptation to the mattress base
- Both sides can be used as lying surfaces
- Reinforced edge zones allow users to sit comfortably on the side of the bed
- Removable reversible cover, one side polyurethane (PU), the other side polyester and viscose, can be washed in a standard washing machine
- Compression hardness 5.0 kPa (edge zones), 4.0 kPa (base layer), 2.5 kPa (top layer), density 50 kg/m³ (base), 40 kg/m³ (top)

Comfort-fit – the mid-range mattress

- The comfortable mattress with a core made of elastic polyurethane cold foam (14 cm)
- Cutouts in the base layer ensure optimum adaptation to the mattress base
- Both sides can be used as lying surfaces
- Edge zone reinforcement prevents falling out of bed
- Removable reversible cover, one side polyurethane (PU), the other side polyester and viscose, can be washed in a standard washing machine
- Compression hardness 5.0 kPa (edge zones), 4.0 kPa (base), density 40 kg/m³



Basic-fit – the entry-level model

- Single-layer mattress made of cosy polyurethane (12 cm)
- White removable PU cover, can be washed in a standard washing machine
- Compression hardness 4.5 kPa, density 40 kg/m³
